LAWS AND STANDARDS

OSHA 1910.151(c):

Where the eyes or body of any person may be exposed to injurious corrosive materials, suitable facilities for quick, drenching or flushing of the eyes and body shall be provided within the work area for immediate emergency use.

ANSI/ISEA Z358.1:

Emergency showers and eyewashes shall be located within 10 seconds' travel time of hazard.
